SASBU Overview

3 x ASB officer

1x shared administrator officer

Population Approximately 275,396 approx. 600 referral per year 300 live cases per year, 25 new case per month, Sefton is statistically the safest place to live on Merseyside

Work closely with: Police, OVH, Riverside, Jigsaw and other Social Landlords, Environmental services

Private Landlords

123,000 households

In 2020 there were a total of 19,386 social housing dwellings within Sefton, owned by 34 providers. 56% of these properties are owned by One Vision Housing Limited and 12% by The Riverside Group Limited (none of the other providers owned over 5% of the stock)



Legislation

SASBU

Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

- Persistent conduct that has caused, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person,
- Persistent conduct capable of causing nuisance or annoyance to a person in relation to that person's occupation of residential premises, or
- Persistent conduct capable of causing housing-related nuisance or annoyance to any person.
- Putting the Victim at the heart of the process (Victim Code)



Powers within the Act

- > civil injunctions
- > criminal behaviour orders
- > public spaces protection orders
- > community protection notices
- dispersal powers
- closure powers
- fixed penalty notice
- out of court disposal

ASB Process

SASBU

- > Referral via Sefton contact centre, Police, Cllrs, Partners
- > Entered on to SASBU Oasis system
- ➤ Initial e-mail/tel contact with the victim with a ASB Reporting pack: ASB Log sheet, Access to the Noise App, Instruction for sending pictures & videos without evidence we cannot proceed **we need proof**
- ➤ Background checks on all involved, address check, police/partners checks, other intel and weekly partners meetings
- ➤ Initial "No Blame" letter to alleged offenders
- > Collation of evidence for evidence case file
- ➤ If case is resolved then case closed as success, of cases, out of court disposal FPN, CPN warning, Full Community Protection Notice (Criminal) mediation etc
- Continued Investigation and evidence gathering (statements & Evidence)
- Consultation with Legal dept, litigation division
- Preparation of Prosecution file for legal consideration
- > Court



Outcomes

SASBU

- ➤ 99% resolved without the need for Court (Out of court disposal)
- Community Protection Notices (over 16 years of age, presently) our go to tool, breach of a CPN is a Criminal Offence

> Court Orders:

- Criminal Behaviour Orders
- Closure Notice,
- Civil Injunctions (including under 16 years old)
- Breach of FPN (Non payment)
- Gang Injunctions (Police led)
- Custody
- Fines up to £2000 for an individual, £20.000 for a business
- Criminal Behaviour Orders (Old ASBO)
- Positive Requirements & Orders to not act in a ASB manner
- > Powers of Arrest attached to an order



Sefton ASB Themes

SASBU



- ➤ Smell of Cannabis 30% of cases, SASBU purchased Cannabis particle detectors to back up victim statements for Court, first LA in the UK to trailblaze this new approach
- > Scrambler Bikes
- Neighbour disputes regarding boundaries, parking, neighbours not liking each other (Not ASB)
- > Kids and Ball games (no enforcement, not ASB)
- > Aggression, Threats, Noise
- Drugs and Alcohol
- ➤ Mental Health
- > CCTV is not ASB, Information Commissioner
