To increase public confidence in Neighbourhood Watch volunteers should adhere to our organisational Code of Ethics and Standards of Behaviour.

HONESTY AND INTEGRITY

As a Neighbourhood Watch volunteer, you are expected to act with honesty, trust, and integrity.

SELFLESSNESS

You act in the interest of your local community.

LEADERSHIP, OBJECTIVITY, AND OPENNESS

You lead by example, showing empathy and encouraging others while offering guidance and support.

CONFIDENTIALITY

You treat information with respect and in accordance with the law.

EQUALITY AND DIVERSITY

You do not discriminate unlawfully or unfairly.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACCOUNTABILITY

As a volunteer, you are active and supportive in your community, helping to build trust and resilience.

CONDUCT

You behave in a manner which does not bring discredit upon Neighbourhood Watch or Neighbourhood Watch partners or undermine public confidence

FAIRNESS, RESPECT, AND COURTESY

You treat everyone with respect and courtesy and act fairly and impartially at all times.
